### ***Flooring 'Fields of England'***

Resin flooring specialists, Conren Limited, recently completed work on a landmark building for the RAF Aircraft Museum at Hendon, North West London.

Levelay HD self-smoothing epoxy screed has been hand-laid by Conren's in-house Contracting Division to an intricate flooring pattern, depicting 'The Fields of England', as a stunning back-drop to a unique display of vintage aircraft.

The high specification resin screed was specially formulated in a range of subtle colours, to meet the Architect's concept design for the project, and laid in over 40 sections to a total area of approx. 1600 m<sup>2</sup>.

The exhibition hall, constructed by Norwest Holst Construction Limited, was officially opened in December 2003 by the Duke of Edinburgh to celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Wright Brothers' first powered flight. The building complements the existing Grade II Listed Museum and the project has received support from the Heritage Lottery Fund with a grant of £4.77 million.
