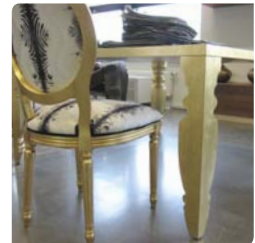


Flowcrete's On Trend in Tallinn City Centre

Flowcrete has been involved in an innovative and high-fashion office flooring project for the popular fashion retailer Baltika Kvartal in Tallinn City Centre.

The design vision for the company's new office building was a hot new trend that brings concrete blocks, thick glass, wood, steel and harsh lighting together to give the new commercial complex an urban and industrialised vibe.

In order to meet the design requirements specified by the project architect, Flowcrete specified its Peran STC resin, a two-component epoxy-based, clear resin system that would achieve the unpolished concrete-style finish that Baltika Kvartal so craved.

Over 8000m² of the system was installed across the entire building including all corridors, stairways, conference rooms and even the offices themselves.

Peran STC not only offers good durability and wear resistance it is also UV-stable - meaning that the colour will not fade over time.

In addition, the product offers high resistance to a number of chemical compounds, making it ideal to withstand all that the office world can throw at it.
