RESDEV ON SHOW AT THE ROYAL GEOGRAPHICAL SOCIETY

Elegant and practical Pumazzo M terrazzo flooring materials manufactured by resin flooring specialists Resdev are creating quite an impression in the recently-opened new extension to the Royal Geographical Society's headquarters on Kensington Gore in London.

Seeking to create a seamless combination of corridors and open spaces, contractors Durkan Pudelek specified the liquid applied terrazzo flooring along a glazed link corridor and into the new building, using a single colour throughout to achieve a spacious and uninterrupted effect. The work was carried out by flooring installation specialists FTL Flooring Ltd.

Resdev's Pumazzo M terrazzo flooring system contains a combination of coloured marble aggregates and graded silica bound within a high performance epoxy resin system, ground off to produce a smooth, polished cosmetic finish.

The end result is an elegant aesthetic finish combined with significant performance benefits offered by a seamless flooring system providing the highest levels of durability, abrasion and impact resistance.

The colour selected for the project is titian cream, a blend of black and brown stone which complements the interior décor and provides an easy to clean finish which offers all the beauty of conventional marble terrazzo at a fraction of the cost.

Covering some 550m² in total, the material creates a smooth expanse of seamless flooring, delivering an aesthetically pleasing overall effect which is further enhanced by the use of pre-cast skirtings made from the same material and colour.
