Remmers win Gold Award

As part of the urban regeneration master plan, a new town centre development has been created by Architects Burke-Kennedy Doyle for Crossridge Investments, around a new town square and the existing millpond at Dundrum in Dublin.

The BCSC (British Council of Shopping Centres) judges in making their Gold Award said "this new focal point for community activities utilises high quality materials throughout, with clever exploitation of the sloping site to incorporate three levels of retailing, all with direct access to 3,500 concealed car parking spaces".

Remmers advanced waterproofing and coating systems were selected for performance and value ahead of all other manufacturers, and they have now been used extensively on this prestige project.

All together more than 110,000 square metres of coloured waterproof car park deck surfacing, and more than 140,000 square metres of protective and decorative coatings to the exposed concrete walls and soffits. These systems were applied in imaginative local designs, by the specialist contractors Lynch and Manning, supported by Remmers distributor Contec Limited.

Additional Remmers products were also used to seal the deck movement joints, to protect asphalt surfaces in the disabled parking areas, and to provide protective and easily cleaned anti-graffiti surfaces on the decorative external renders.
