### FeRFA's apprenticeship scheme goes north of the border

FeRFA has been successfully running apprenticeship schemes for in situ resin flooring for over five years in England and Wales, and last month it extended this opportunity to companies in Scotland. Working in conjunction with ConstructionSkills Scotland, the FeRFA scheme gives Scottish candidates access to specialist training, delivered in Scotland.

The scheme runs over a two year period, involving classroom, practical and onsite supervised experience, leading to an SVQ Level 2 Diploma in Insitu Resin Flooring.

Seven candidates from FeRFA contractors Industrial Floor Treatments Ltd of East Kilbride and Veitchi Industrial Flooring of Rutherglen have enrolled on the scheme and started their first training session in July.

The willingness of FeRFA members to invest in training through apprenticeships demonstrates their continuing commitment and acknowledgement of the importance of having a fully trained workforce.
