FeRFA launches third group of Resin Flooring Apprentices

Following the launch of the first ever apprenticeship scheme for in situ resin flooring at the end of 2006, FeRFA now has its third group of trainees who all took part in an initial two-day Health & Safety training session at The Preparation Group's training centre in Lincoln.

Once again the apprentices are being guided through their 2 year training programme by Terry Foxley who has a wealth of experience in the industry. The formal sessions are a mixture of classroom based learning and hands-on practical sessions which are held at FeRFA member's training facilities around the country and give the trainees an indepth understanding and practical knowledge on safe working practices, project planning, surface preparation and the installation of resin flooring systems .

The course, set up in conjunction with the ConstructionSkills, will eventually lead to a full NVQ Level 2 in In Situ Resin Flooring and will provide a qualified and skilled workforce for the future. Successful candidates obtain the CSCS Blue Skilled Card as well as the FeRFA ID badge.

Candidates are from four FeRFA contractor companies IRL Group Ltd (Loughborough) Kemtile Ltd (Warrington) Respol (Telford) and Reprotect UK Ltd (Durham).

FeRFA now offers two apprenticeship schemes, Resin Flooring and Surface Preparation, both demonstrating FeRFA's commitment to raising quality standards within the resin flooring industry.
