FeRFA's launches its 4th programme of apprentices

FeRFA's successful apprenticeship programme goes from strength to strength with the launch of its 4th scheme for In Situ Resin Flooring.

The 2009/10 group will start training on 29 April to 1 May. The first three modules, held over the three days, cover the scheme induction and introduction to the NVQ and Generic Health and Safety / Fire safety. During these modules candidates, who have not taken the health and safety test to obtain a CSCS card, will be given tuition and put through the on-screen test. Future modules give the trainees the opportunity to gain hands-on practical experience, with a range of products, as well as gaining an understanding of the methods of use, selection of resins and site safety in classroom sessions. Full details of the full programme and module syllabus can be downloaded from the website.

Grants, which cover the cost of the training, are available to members and there are two routes to funding for apprentices, dependent on previous qualifications.
