TRAINING NEWS

17th GROUP OF FeRFA APPRENTICES START THEIR TRAINING



Ten new apprentices were welcomed to the training scheme for in situ resin flooring this month. This is the 17th resin group since the schemes, leading to and NVQ level 2, were started ten years ago.

For these first sessions the apprentices were given an introduction to the course and an in-depth health & safety training module delivered by Terry Foxley, the FeRFA trainer. They also had the opportunity to meet with their Apprentice Officer and receive an induction from CITB. Read more...

RESIN 14 GO WITH THE FLOW AND COMPLETE PRACTICAL TRAINING

The 14th group of resin apprentices finished their formal training this month with their final session on flowable screeds, this included a day of classroom tuition with Terry Foxley, the FeRFA Trainer, followed by a second day of practical sessions.

FeRFA member, Instarmac, supplied all the materials and hosted the training at their Tamworth facility. PFT Central were on hand to guide the apprentices through each step of the process of mixing and laying pumped screeds. The group were shown the correct setting up procedure of the M-tec mixing pump, preparation of the floor area, setting levels, how to carry out flow tests and safe operation of the pump. NVQ LEVEL 3 OCCUPATIONAL WORK SUPERVISION

The next NVQ level 3 in Occupational Work Supervision will start on **26 & 27 May** (two days) to be held in Nottingham.

If you have any suitable candidates ready to take the next step in their career path, please get in contact with FeRFA for full details on the course.

It is 10 day course which takes three months and consists of 9 Modules (which are taken over 10 days as off-site training). It aims to raise the general standards of supervisors and equips them to deal with the increasing documentation and awareness involving safety and other legislation.

The cost per candidate is £2120 for the courses and £400 towards their students Level 3 NVQ Diploma, and a CITB grant is available of £1950. This includes all the training plus food and accommodation for the training days.

This course meets all the requirements of the UKCG Training Standards for Supervisors.

NVQ LEVEL 6 COURSE STARTING ON 17 & 18 MAY

We are enrolling candidates for the next NVQ 6 (Construction Contracting Operations Management) which will start on 17th and 18th May in Nottingham. The course includes 12 days, in two day sessions around 6 weeks apart, in the classroom and at the same time candidates will work, using on-line workbooks, to gather a portfolio of evidence during that time. The process will be fully explained at the first sessions. Once the programme is complete and enough evidence has been gathered candidates will achieve their qualification.

The programme covers the following modules:

Resource Management

Leadership and Management + Communication and Customer Care

Health and Safety

Planning, Programming and Logistics

Health & Safety (CDM) + Environmental and Sustainability

The course is cost neutral in that the fees are £2,800 + VAT and grants are available for CITB levy payers totalling £2,800. Hotel accommodation can be booked locally to the course if required, at £50 + VAT per person, per night and includes breakfast but no evening meal.

RECYCLING - ARE YOU TAKING PART?

Looking at the data submitted by members for the first quarter of 2016, we are on schedule to reach (and hopefully surpass) our prevous totals - which in themselves have increased year on year.


FeRFA has simplified the way it is gathering waste statistics from members to maximise the opportunity for all members to submit data. We now require two figures per month - total weight collected and total weight recycled or recovered. <u>An easy to use template can be downloaded from the FeRFA Members Area under the Recycling section.</u>

If you use <u>Reconomy</u> as your waste provider, you do not have to provide separate statistics.

Only those companies that provide waste statistics will be able to display the recycling logo with the company entry on the website.

GUIDANCE ON THE NEW APPRENTICESHIP LEVY

BIS has published guidance on how the <u>Apprenticeship levy</u> will work when it is introduced on 6 April 2017, the first in a series of guidance notes for employers.

The guidance is easy to read and confirms the following points:

- The levy will be calculated and paid monthly through the PAYE process
- Levy funds can only be spent on apprenticeships
- At first only those that pay the levy will be able to access funding from the apprenticeship levy fund
- In England the amount each employer will receive will be the levy they have paid plus a 10% top up from the Government
- Employers will have up to 18 months to spend each levy payment made
- Training providers and assessment organisations will have to be approved and registered to receive payments from the apprenticeship levy fund.

REGULATORY ROUND UP FROM B&CE

The arrival of the new tax year on 6 April brought with it some regulatory changes.

Here's all you need to know at your fingertips on pensions, including automatic enrolment – click the links for more info:

- > the <u>upper level of qualifying earnings</u> for automatic enrolment has gone up
- employers need to complete their <u>re-declaration of compliance</u>, within 5 months of the third anniversary of their staging date, even if they haven't anyone to re-enrol
- there are new exceptions to an <u>employer's duty</u> to automatically enrol a worker
- the standard <u>lifetime allowance</u> has reduced from £1.25m to £1m, but it may be possible to protect pension savings from the reduction
- there's a new <u>tapered annual allowance</u> for high earners.

To help people save more for their retirement, all employers must now put certain types of employees into a pension
