National Apprenticeship Week runs from 14 - 18 March and is designed to celebrate apprenticeships and the positive impact they have on individuals, businesses and the wider economy.

Apprenticeships have certainly made their impact on the resin flooring, screeding and surface preparation industry by positively encouraging newcomers into this sector, and by providing employers with a structured training route to qualify existing employees. With two new groups of apprentices going through the scheme each year since 2007, the FeRFA apprenticeship schemes are now a tried and tested route to provide a skilled and qualified workforce for the future.



The latest resin, surface preparation and screed apprenticeship groups will be commencing their two-year training programme in April. With the support of CITB grant funding, apprenticeships are the most cost effective way to train employees, raise quality standards and guarantee the future of specialist skill sectors.

NEW APPRENTICESHIPS STARTS IN APRIL

FeRFA will be starting new Apprenticeships in Screeding, Resin Flooring and Surface Preparation on 6 & 7 April.

The two-year schemes all lead to an NVQ Level 2 Diploma and the scheme is fully grant funded for CITB registered employers and the grant available is up to £8,970. The cost of the schemes are £6,000 per candidate payable over two years.

The current CITB funding for specialist apprenticeship schemes is very advantageous to employers, however there is no guarantee that this level of funding will be available when the new grants are announced in August so this may be a good opportunity to put a candidate forward and enable you to recoup CITB levy payments for training.

ONE DAY UPSKILLING IN SPECIFYING AND SELECTING RESIN FLOORING

Following high demand we will be running this course on two dates as follows:

- Wednesday 9 March at Altro Floors, Works Road, Letchworth, Herts SG6 1NW - LIMITED AVAILABILITY
- Wednesday 30 March at Premier Meetings Carlisle J44, Parkhouse Road, Carlisle, Cumbria CA3 0JR - LIMITED AVAILABILITY
- Wednesday 13 April at a Instarmac, Danny Morson Way, Birch Coppice Business Park, Dordon, Tamworth, Staffs B78 1SE - LIMITED AVAILABILITY

The cost is just £50 each (for FeRFA Members) which includes all training, course papers, lunch and refreshments. A certificate will also be issued on successful completion of the course.

You may also be eligible for grant funding of £50 (daily training plan rate). Details on claiming grant will be sent on booking together with joining details and invoice (to be paid prior to course date please).

Full details of the programme for the day will be sent to delegates but the course, which is classroom based, will cover:

- > Types of Resin Flooring (FeRFA Classification) and characteristics
- Areas of application
- Selection process- questions you need to ask
- Selling into Specialist Markets (such as Food & Beverage, Automotive, Healthcare, Retail & Manufacturing, etc.)
- Top Ten Tips for correct selection

NVQ LEVEL 3 OCCUPATIONAL WORK SUPERVISION

The next NVQ level 3 in Occupational Work Supervision will start on 26 & 27 May (two days) to be held in Nottingham.

If you have any suitable candidates ready to take the next step in their career path, please get in contact with FeRFA for full details on the course.

It is 10 day course which takes three months and consists of 9 Modules (which are taken over 10 days as off-site training). It

aims to raise the general standards of supervisors and equips them to deal with the increasing documentation and awareness involving safety and other legislation.

The cost per candidate is £2120 for the courses and £400 towards their students Level 3 NVQ Diploma, and a CITB grant is available of £1950. This includes all the training plus food and accommodation for the training days.

This course meets all the requirements of the UKCG Training Standards for Supervisors.

NVQ LEVEL 6 COURSE STARTING ON 17 & 18 MAY

We are enrolling candidates for the next NVQ 6 (Construction Contracting Operations Management) which will start on 17th and 18th May in Nottingham. The course includes 12 days, in two day sessions around 6 weeks apart, in the classroom and at the same time candidates will work, using on-line workbooks, to gather a portfolio of evidence during that time. The process will be fully explained at the first sessions. Once the programme is complete and enough evidence has been gathered candidates will achieve their qualification.

The programme covers the following modules:

Resource Management

Leadership and Management + Communication and Customer Care

Health and Safety

Planning, Programming and Logistics

Health & Safety (CDM) + Environmental and Sustainability

The course is cost neutral in that the fees are £2,800 + VAT and grants are available for CITB levy payers totalling £2,800. Hotel accommodation can be booked locally to the course if required, at £50 + VAT per person, per night and includes breakfast but no evening meal.

APPRENTICES TRAIN AT RESDEV'S BRAND NEW RESIN TECHNOLOGY CENTRE AND AT SIKA

Apprentices took their Screeds and Coving module with FeRFA trainer, Terry Foxley, at Resdev's newly opened Resin Technology Centre in Elland.

The aim of the three days is to give the apprentices plenty of practical hands-on experience and the group thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to apply quartz materials and gain practice on their trowel work to take those skills into the workplace. On the final day, FeRFA trainer, Terry Foxley gave the learners a review of the course as a whole and guidance on the next steps in the apprentices' progress towards achieving their NVQ level 2 Diplomas. The group will take the final module on flowable screeds in April.

Resdev provided all the materials for the sessions and the apprentice worked in pairs to perfect their techniques in screeding and coving on purpose built wooden frames.

Also training this month were the 15th group of FeRFA resin flooring apprentices, who took their resin coatings module at Sika's training facilities at Welwyn Garden City. As well as providing classroom facilities, Sika provided all the necessary materials for the practical sessions. The candidates gained valuable guidance and hands-on experience during the two days

The apprentices in this group are: Christopher Davey & Liam King (IRL Group Ltd), Alex Bowers (John Lord & Son Ltd), Paul Ratcliffe, Anthony Rowell and Matthew Haines (Midland Industrial Flooring), Anthony O'Keeffe (Senso), Robert Atkins (Central Flooring Services).

The apprentices now have to complete their modules on Self Smoothing, Screeds and Coving and finally, Flowable Screeds. They will then continue to work with their employers, supervised on-site, to reach the necessary proficiency to be assessed for their NVQ level 2 Diplomas.


FeRFA Business Shield has been created to help FeRFA members access professional, competent advice on Health & Safety and Employment Law matters <u>at no extra cost</u>.

RECYCLING - ARE YOU TAKING PART?


With a new year just started, we are looking forward to what can be achieved in 2016 in respect of our recycling inititative.

If you use <u>Reconomy</u> as your waste provider, your figures are included automatically in the graph below, if you are using another waste provider to remove your waste you can still submit your data to FeRFA. There is an easy-to use template that can be completed using the details from your waste provider and enables you to produce evidence to give to your clients.

We will be sending a copy of the new template and instructions on how to complete it and make your returns to FeRFA in the coming weeks. Only those companies that provide waste statistics will be able to display the recycling logo with the company entry on the website.
