CORONAVIRUS (Covid-19)

Construction Industry Recognition

Earlier in November, Secretary of State for Business, Industry, Energy & Industrial Strategy, Alok Sharma wrote an open letter to those in the construction sector, thanking them for their contribution during the Coronavirus pandemic. Read the letter here.

Self-Employment Income Support Scheme

Applications have now opened for the third grant under the Self-Employment Income Support Scheme. A business must have experienced a negative impact from coronavirus between 1 November 2020 and 31 January 2021 in order to submit a claim before the deadline of Friday 29 January.

Changes to Safe Travel Guidance

From Wednesday 2 December, new local restriction tiers will apply in England, and the Government has updated its Safer travel guidance accordingly. Across all tiers, people should walk or cycle if they can, avoid the busiest routes and peak travel times, and avoid car sharing with anyone outside their household or support bubble.

People living in a High or Very High tier should reduce the number of journeys they make,

and travel into and out of Very High areas should be avoided other than where necessary, such as for work. In the event of construction workers being stopped on journeys to and from sites, Build UK has produced an authorisation letter template which employers can use.

INDUSTRY NEWS

Free e-Course: Setting Up & Operating a Safe Construction Site

As the second national lockdown in England was announced, CITB launched a free Covid-19 e-Course. Already, in just four weeks, more than 1,400 people have completed the training. It covers topics such as current legislation; how a virus spreads; social distancing and risk management. The course can be taken at any time, and you can find out more here.

Construction Skills Network: Industry Outlook 2021-2025 Report

In partnership with Experian, CITB have released their Industry Outlook for 2021-2025. The summary document presents three scenarios about how the economy will recover, and what they mean for construction. All suggest that a recovery will not be as rapid as initially hoped for, but that by working together, we can address the key skill challenges. Read the report here.

Help Shape the Levy

This year, after speaking to the Prescribed Organisations and some employers, CITB decided that it was inappropriate to run the Consensus process when the external environment was so unstable and uncertain. Their expectation is that, although some Covid-related uncertainty will remain, the external environment will be sufficiently stable to run the Consensus process next year. The final decision will be taken by the CITB Board in February and before doing so CITB will seek views from the Prescribed Organisations, which are made up of several trade federations, as well as analysing other economic and industry insights to inform our recommendations to the Board.

In the meantime, CITB have been setting up the Levy Strategy Committee of employers and experts to recommend new Levy Proposals and support a longer term review of the Levy. The committee met for the first time in November, but they have one vacancy for an independent member that isn't employed by a Levy-registered employer. If you have extensive experience of the industry and you work in an organisation that isn't a CITB registered employer, please consider joining.



Materials Supply Report

Build UK has worked with the Chartered Institute of Procurement and Supply (CIPS) to publish a detailed report on the supply of construction materials after the end of the Brexit transition period. The report, which will be regularly updated, identifies which materials may be in short supply or have longer lead times.

CLC Updates Card Schemes Recommendation

Following Build UK's Smartcard Audit 2019, which identified the need for more cards carrying the CSCS logo to go smart, the Construction Leadership Council (CLC) has updated its Industry Card Schemes Recommendation. From 31 March 2022, all card schemes will be required to use smart technology, which has the capability to electronically check agreed information relevant to a cardholder, using a common interface, without the need to manually enter data.

Sites are asked to use the technology available to ensure cards are genuine and that workers have the appropriate qualifications and training for the occupation they are undertaking.

It is easy to do using the datasheet (if not using Reconomy) - only two figures are needed per month - total weight collected and total weight recycled or recovered. This is information that should be provided by your waste collector. If it isn't then ask them why not. The spreadsheet includes a graph, automatically generated from your figures - which you can show to prospective clients
